



Assembly Instructions: Single Produce and Tool Storage Box - 4 Layers

Contents:

4 x 60cm Posts

8 x Ended Slats with baton

2 x Ended Slats, no baton

4 x Shelves each with 7 thin slats joined with jute webbing.

Assemble the bottom layer, joining the posts together by sliding Ended Slats down the grooves of the posts. Place with the cut-out side downwards. Use 4 Slats, 2 with and 2 without a baton. Placing similar Ended Slats opposite to each other. That is, if you read the spaces between the posts in a circle there would be one slat without a baton, then one slat with a baton, without again, then on the fourth side a slat with a baton. The batons should face inwards.



Add three Slats with a baton, one above the other, to a side that already has a similar slat at the bottom. Do the same on the opposite side, placing the Shelves, webbing down on each level as you go.

The Recycle Works have produced this storage item just for you. The white wood is FSC certificated and slow grown in Sweden for strength and lasting properties. Each piece is examined before dispatch to assure quality. The wood is left bare as it is intended for produce storage. However some like to paint it for other uses, for example tool storage in a shed/garage.
