# HERB GARDENS - SQUARE FOOT GARDENING ROW - DOUBLE ROW - SQUARE - CASCADES

One Herb Garden Five Line Herb Garden

Twin Herb Garden Five Line Herb Garden Raised Centre Bed

Three Line Herb Garden Double Three (Six) Herb Garden

Three Line Herb Garden, Raised Centre Nine Square Herb Garden

Four Square Herb Garden Nine Square Herb Garden Raised Centre Bed

Four Line Herb Garden Double Five (Ten) Herb Garden

Double Four (Eight) Herb Garden Cascades to choice!

With each Herb Garden the concept of assembly is the same. Consider the footprint you have chosen and decide where to place it. Posts will vary in height if your Herb Bed varies in eight.

#### For a LONG Herb Garden

- 1. Start by making a square using four Posts and four Boards.
- 2. Placing a post over the end of a board then add another board at right angles. Then complete a square using four boards and four posts.
- 3. Add a further bed by choosing the side from which you want to extend. Make another square using this side adding three more sides using three boards and two posts.
- 4. Continue until you have the desired footprint.
- 5. If your Herb Garden is two or three boards high, use the relevant shallow, standard and deep posts appropriately.

### For a SQUARE Herb Garden start at one corner

1. Repeat as above until you have the desired SQUARE footprint. The final square will only require two sides and a single post.

#### For DOUBLE Row Herb Garden start at one end

# **SPECIAL NINE SQUARE Herb Garden with Raised Centre Bed**

- 1. **Start in the center** using the 4 LONGER Posts as the starting point.
- 2. Then work four Herb Beds around the center Herb Bed each using three boards and two posts. You should have five sections now.
- 3. Fill the corner beds using two Boards and a single post.

## Cascades are fun! They are personal. You make them your own.

### For a CASCADE

With each Herb Garden the concept of assembly is the same. Consider the footprint you have chosen and decide where to place it. Posts will vary in height if your Herb Bed varies in eight. See Assembly for LONG Herb Gardens.
