

<u>Assembly</u>

JUBILEE PLANTERS Big Square – Classic – Compact – Long - Small Planter

Contents:

4 Posts with a drill hole in the top8 Plastic Slats 18cm2 Boards with a baton

10 Side Boards 1 Floor 4 Caps for posts

- The top of the posts have drill holes.
- Slide two plastic slats at right angles to each other into the bottom of each post.
- Slide a board between two of the posts making sure that it sits on top of a plastic slat at each end.
- On either side of this board, at right angles to the first board, place a board with a baton on it, baton inside, again making sure that it sits on top of a plastic slat at each end
- Finish the square with an ended board between the last two posts again on top of plastic slats. Check that the batons are opposite to each other on the inside.
- Rest the floor on the batons. They should be on opposite sides inside the base of the planter.
- Fill the sides with more boards to the top.
- Screw on the caps making sure that they are squared off visually.
- Add the liner, if included, before filling with compost and planting out.
- Hoops are available to use for tall planting. They will also act as a support for crop protection.
