

## Assembly GARDENING WORKS POTTING TABLE SINGLE SIDE - DOUBLE SIDED

Contents:

SINGLE Potting Bench Posts: 2 x Tall, 2 x Short

Table Tops: 1

Black Plastic Strips: 2

Baton Boards: 1 x Long, 2 x Short

Boards: Long, short

Shelf: 1

DOUBLE SIDED Potting Bench

Posts: 2 x Tall, 4 x Short

Table Tops: 2

Black Plastic Strips: 4

Baton Boards: 1 x Long Double, 4 x Short

Shelf: 2

Assembly pictures on the website are helpful

Assembly - Preferably in situ

- Slide one long board between the two tall posts as a foundation to the center (back) panel.
- At right angles to this board add a short board to the left and right. Place a short post over the other end of each board.
- Fill the sides with short boards placing the baton boards on the top, facing inside.
- Build up the center panel with long boards to the same height as the sides with the long baton board at the same level as those at the sides. Add the remaining long boards keeping one back for the front panel(s) center panel.
- Slide in the pre-assembled shelf.
- The plastic strips act as retainers for the front board. Slide one strip into a post grove each side opposite each other to support the last board where one's knees would go. The slats need to be opposite and facing each other on the inner sides of the front posts. Above these strips place the remaining board, baton inside and at the top.
- Place the Table Tops to rest on the baton boards.
